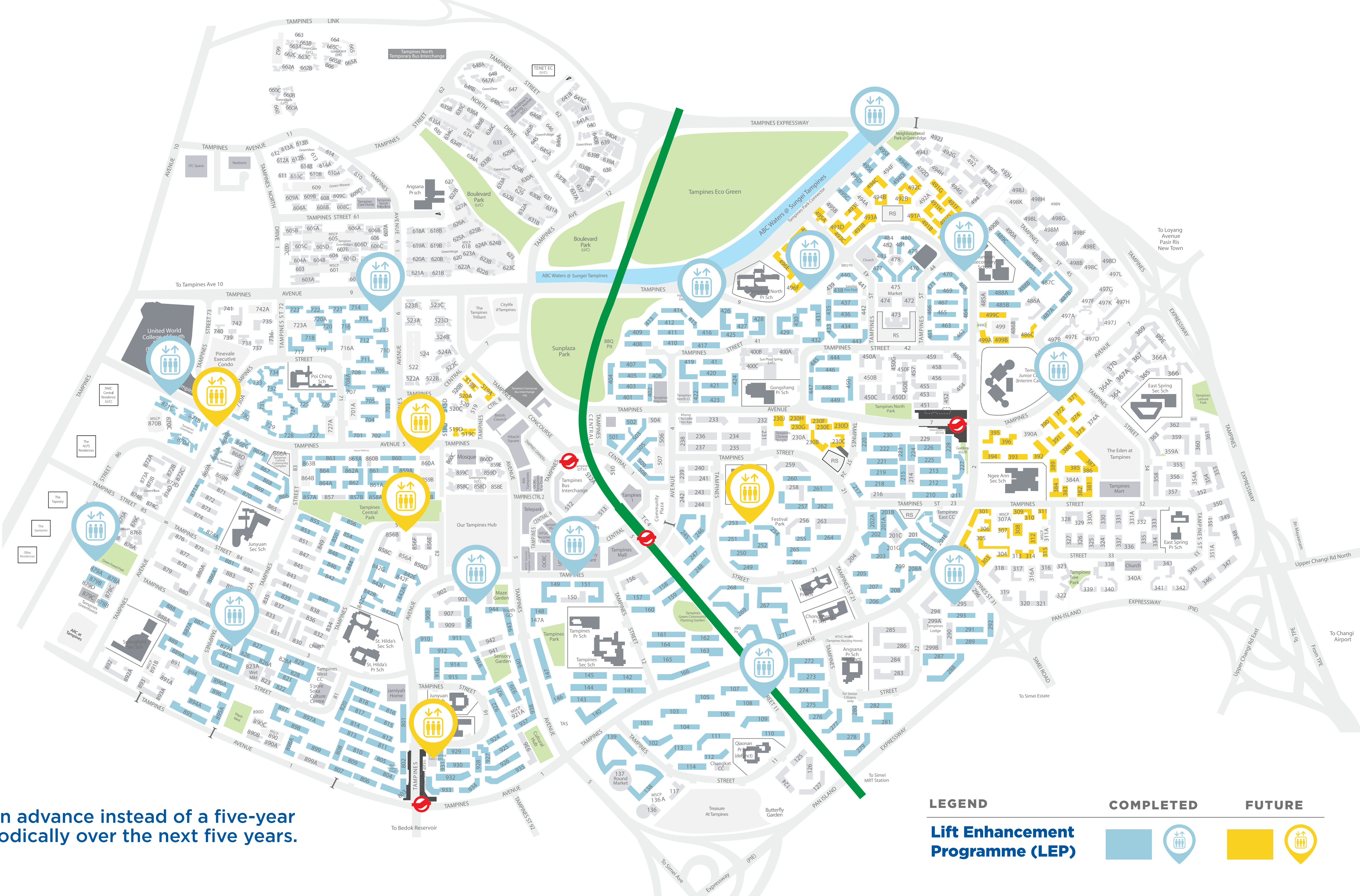
Lifting You Safely

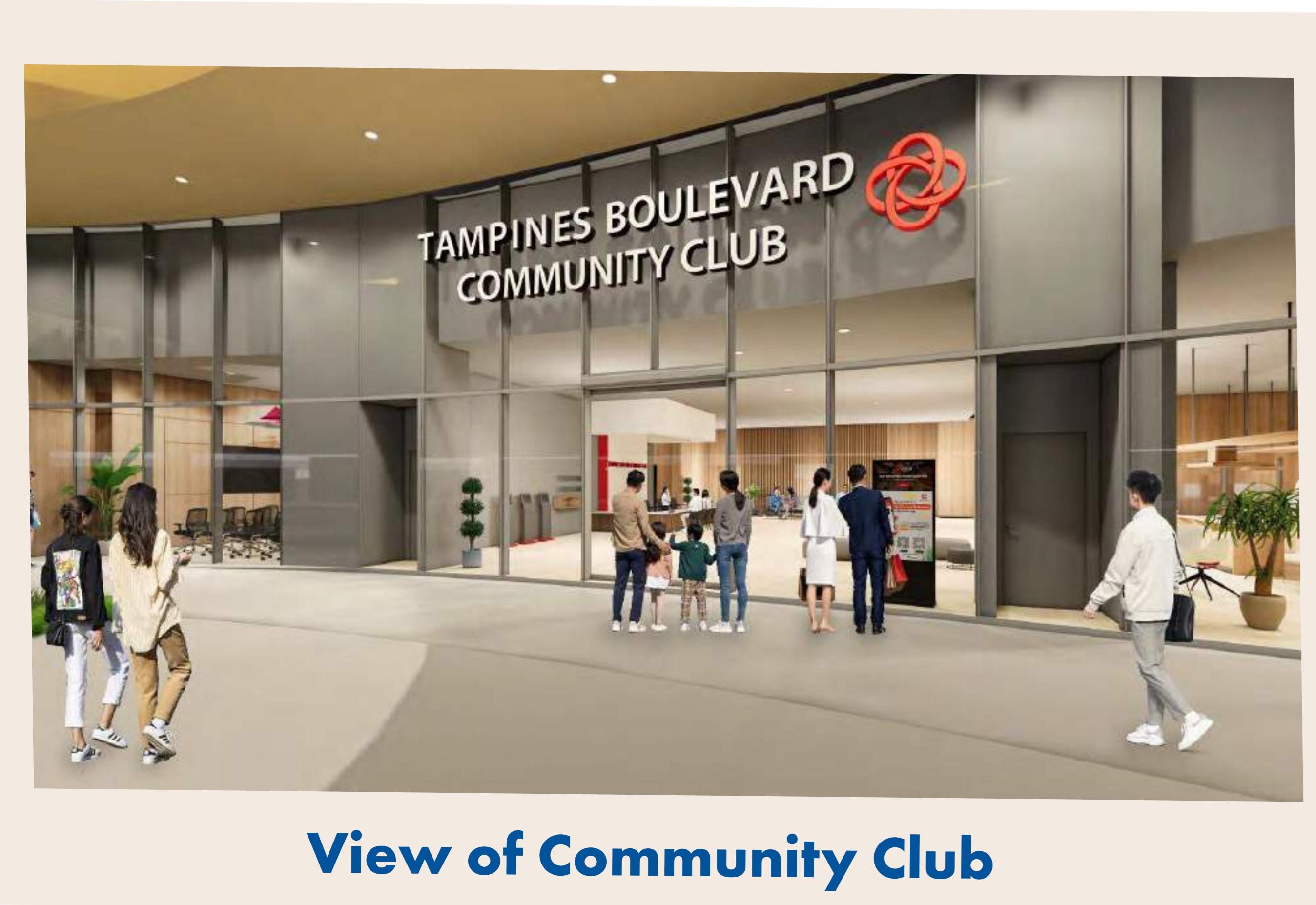

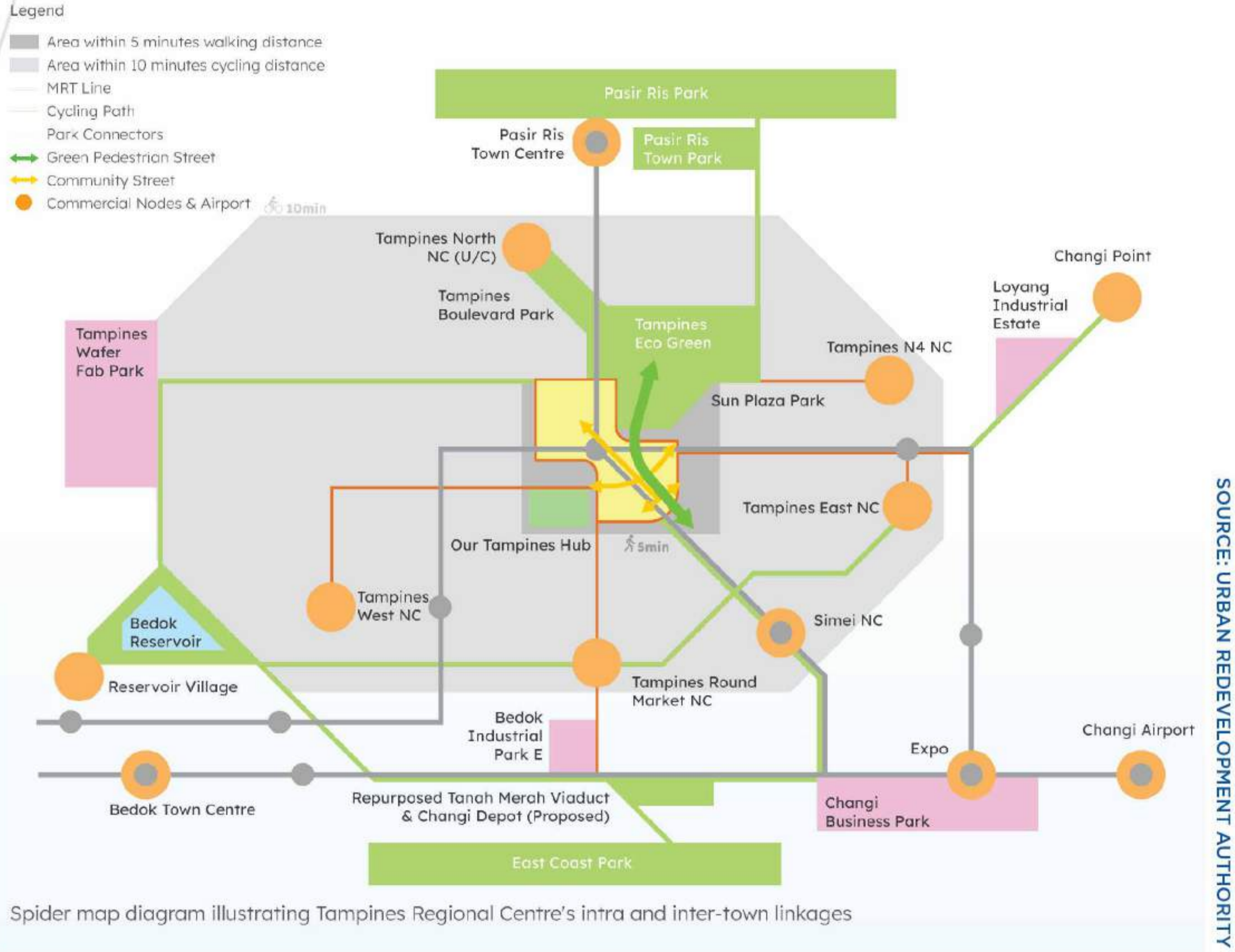
An Even Better Tampines Regional Centre

We will revitalise the Tampines Regional Centre (TRC) with improvements like new amenities and better connectivity.

These enhancements will create a vibrant, convenient and sustainable hub for residents and businesses.

Well Connected To the Wider East Region and The Rest Of Singapore With two MRT lines (East-West and Downtown Lines), a bus interchange and an extensive cycling network, Tampines is Singapore's most well-connected regional centre*.

- Improve infrastructure to promote active mobility and walkability
- Create more versatile spaces that can adapt to different uses and future needs
- Improve connectivity to adjacent areas such as Our Tampines Hub, Sun Plaza Park and other parts of Tampines

- New mixed-use developments with homes, shops and an Integrated Transport Hub
- Easier bus-train transfers at key transport spots and a new public space at the heart of TRC
- A smooth pedestrian street with better-sheltered walkways above and underground, with possible road network changes

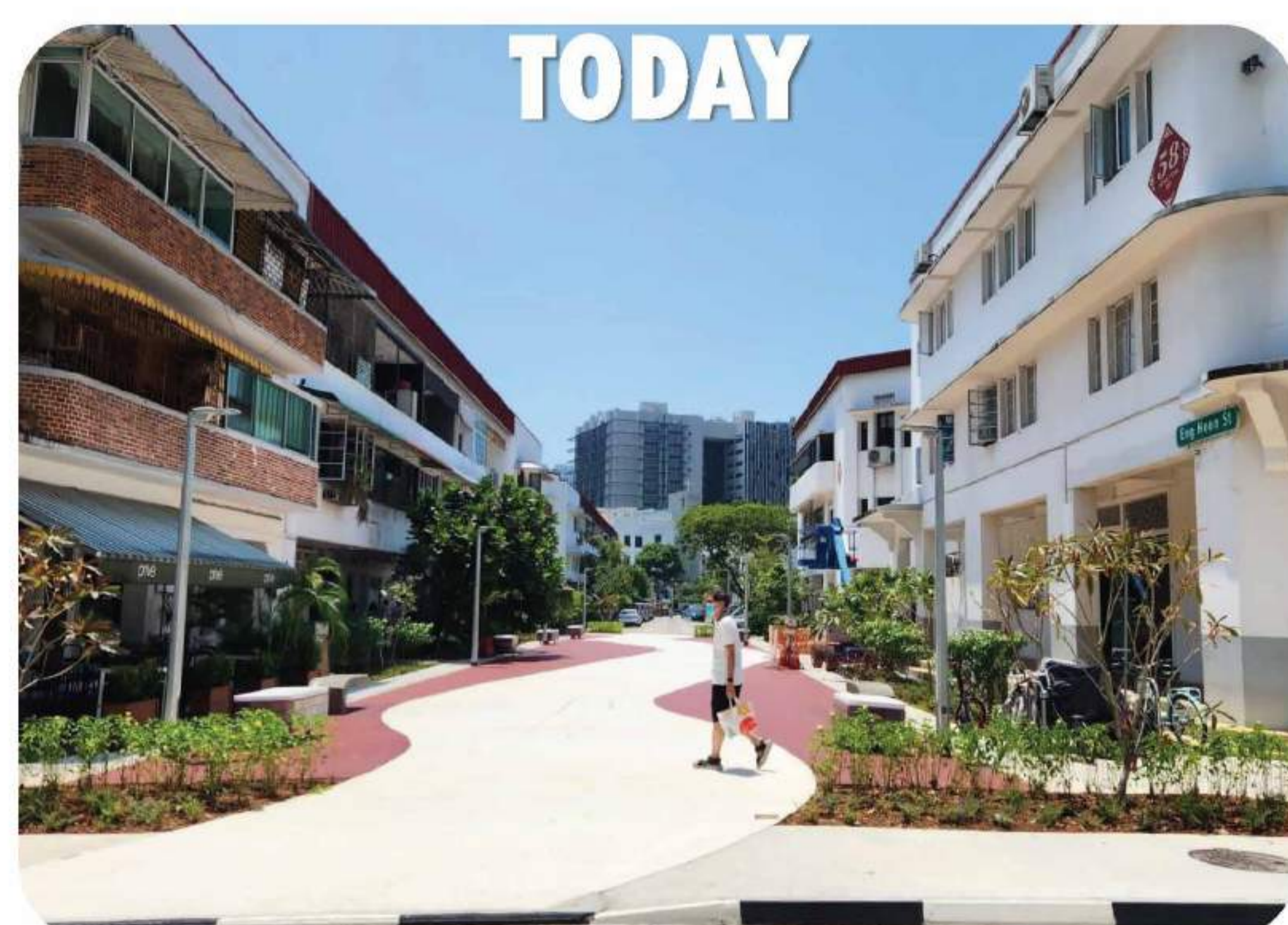

By 2027, the cycling paths will be increased to 40 km.

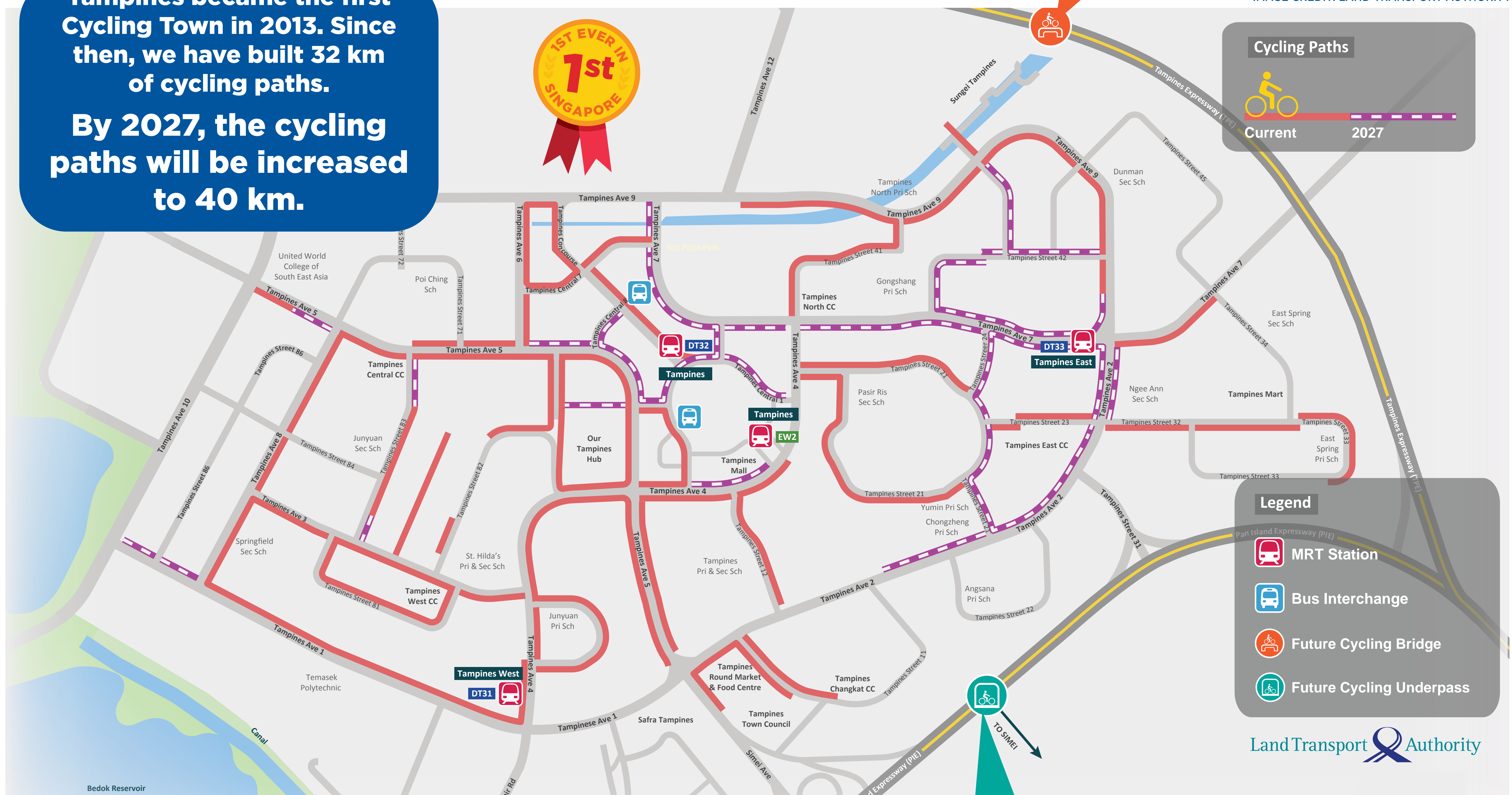

Ready To Meet Your Future Transport Needs

The new Tampines North transport hub, with its dedicated bus interchange and MRT station, will complement the existing hub in the town centre, making Tampines the most connected town.

Crossing The Island In Half The Time

The Tampines North MRT station on the Cross Island Line (CRL) connects residents to interchange stations in Ang Mo Kio, Bright Hill, Hougang and Pasir Ris.

With the fifth MRT station in Tampines, travelling time will be cut by half. Going to Ang Mo Kio will take 20 mins instead of 50 mins.

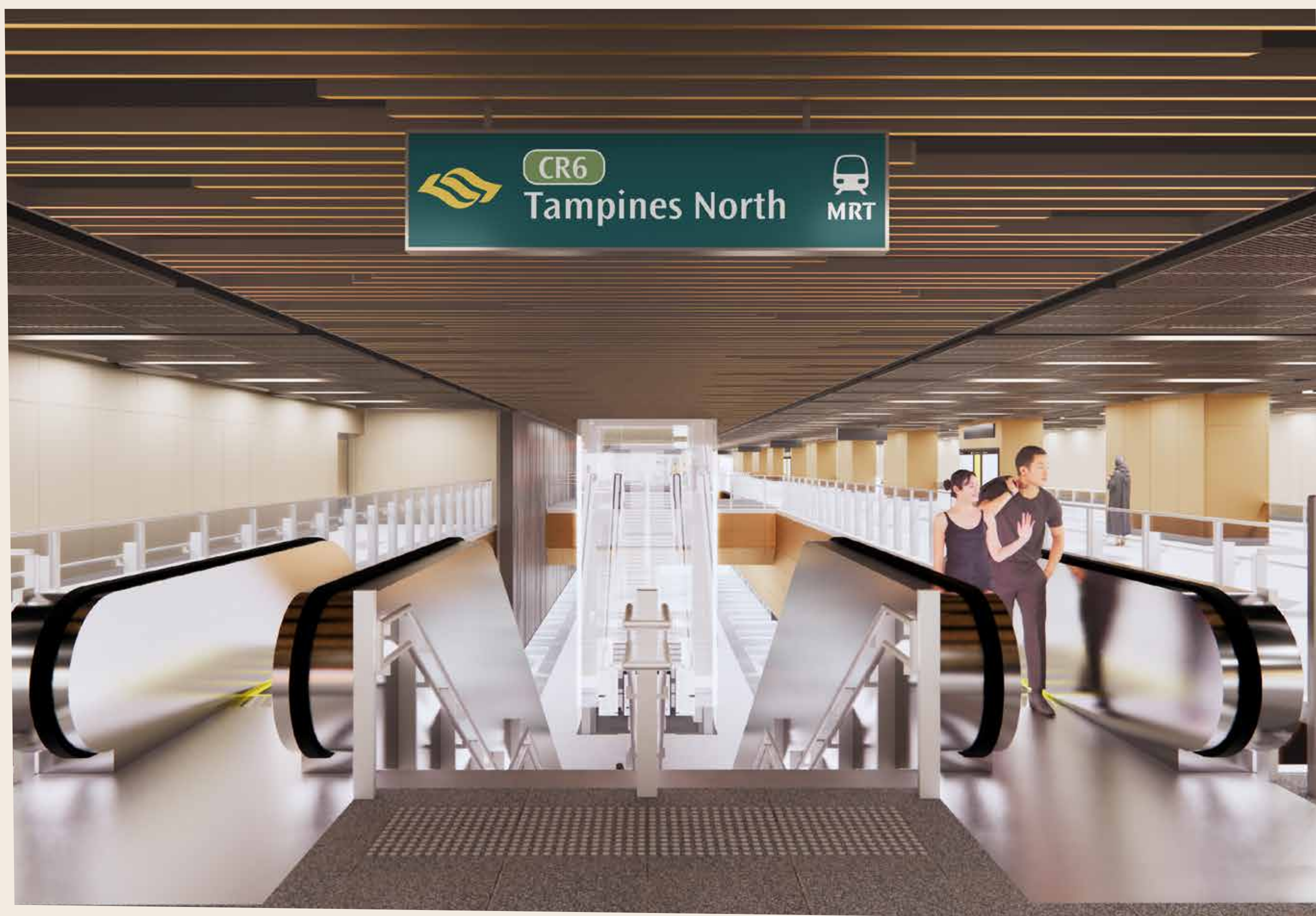

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More Express Buses, Less Travel Time

For BTO residents living farther away from the town centre, the Bus Connectivity Enhancement Programme provides a new “express feeder” bus service in Tampines.

Tampines residents are the first to enjoy the convenience provided by the new programme. Bus service 298X takes fewer intermediate stops than the existing feeder services.

Sustainable Living Made Easy For You

Tampines is a test bed for the latest technologies in sustainability. The aim is for all residents to have easy access to facilities that support a sustainable lifestyle, whether it is buying fresh fish from the neighbourhood farm or recycling food waste at the Black Soldier Fly facility.

Sustainability @ Tampines Park

Singapore's First Community-Based Circular Ecosystem For Food Production



Residents play a part in community eco-resilience

- 1 - Food waste from residents is collected and fed to Black Soldier Fly larvae, a type of decomposer.
- 2 - The nutrition-packed Black Soldier Fly larvae will be processed and fed to the tilapia in the fish farm, while the excreta (frass) is used to fertilise vegetables in a nearby community garden.
- 3 - The vegetables and tilapia will then be harvested, completing the cycle.

Recycling Food Waste As A Community

Residents receive green points when they contribute their food waste to the Black Soldier Fly facility. These can be used to redeem vegetables and tilapia fish farmed at the Tampines Park.

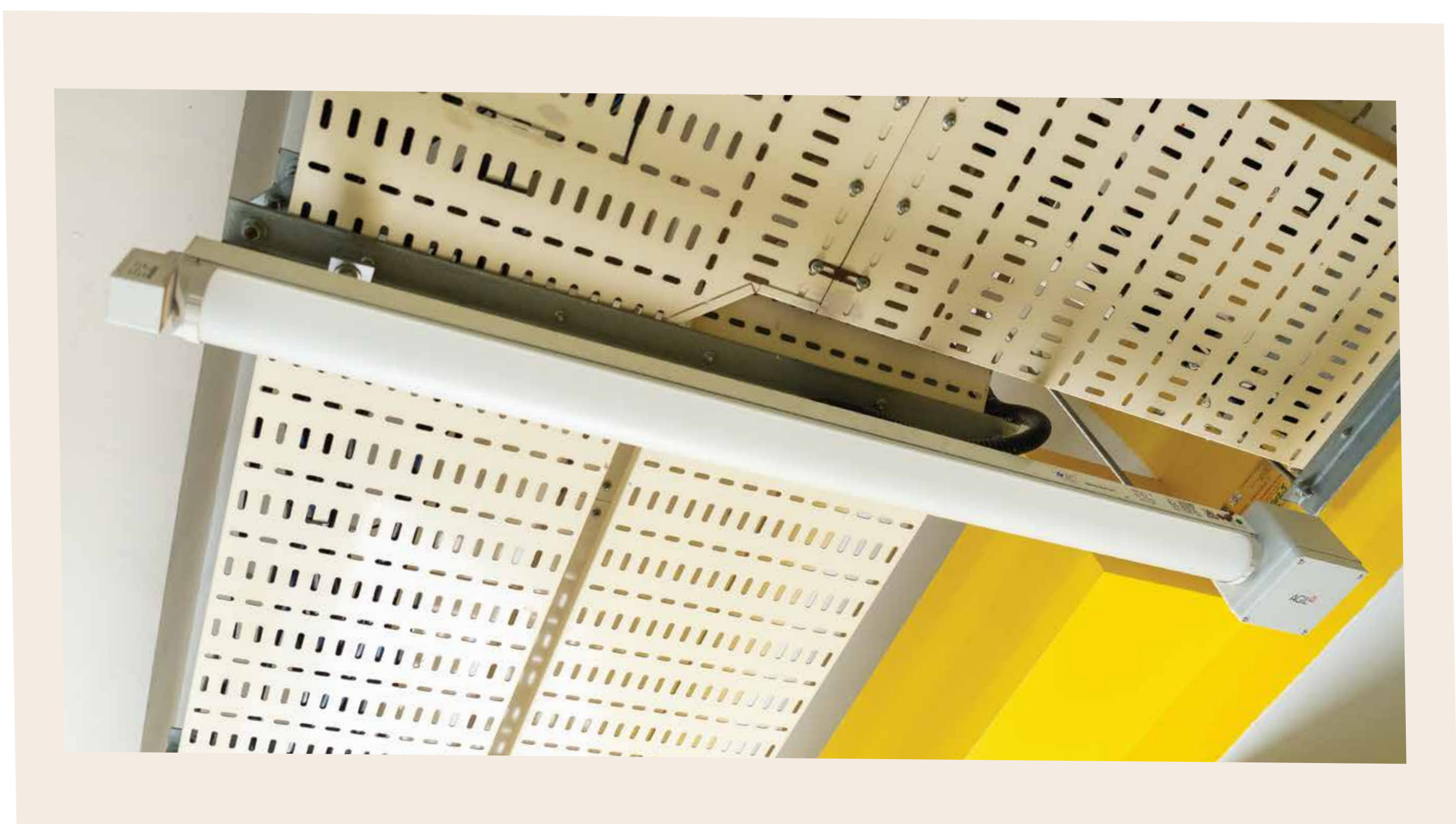


The lamps detect movement and will automatically adjust the brightness of LED lights in common areas. This **saves up to 60% energy** on top of savings from using LED.

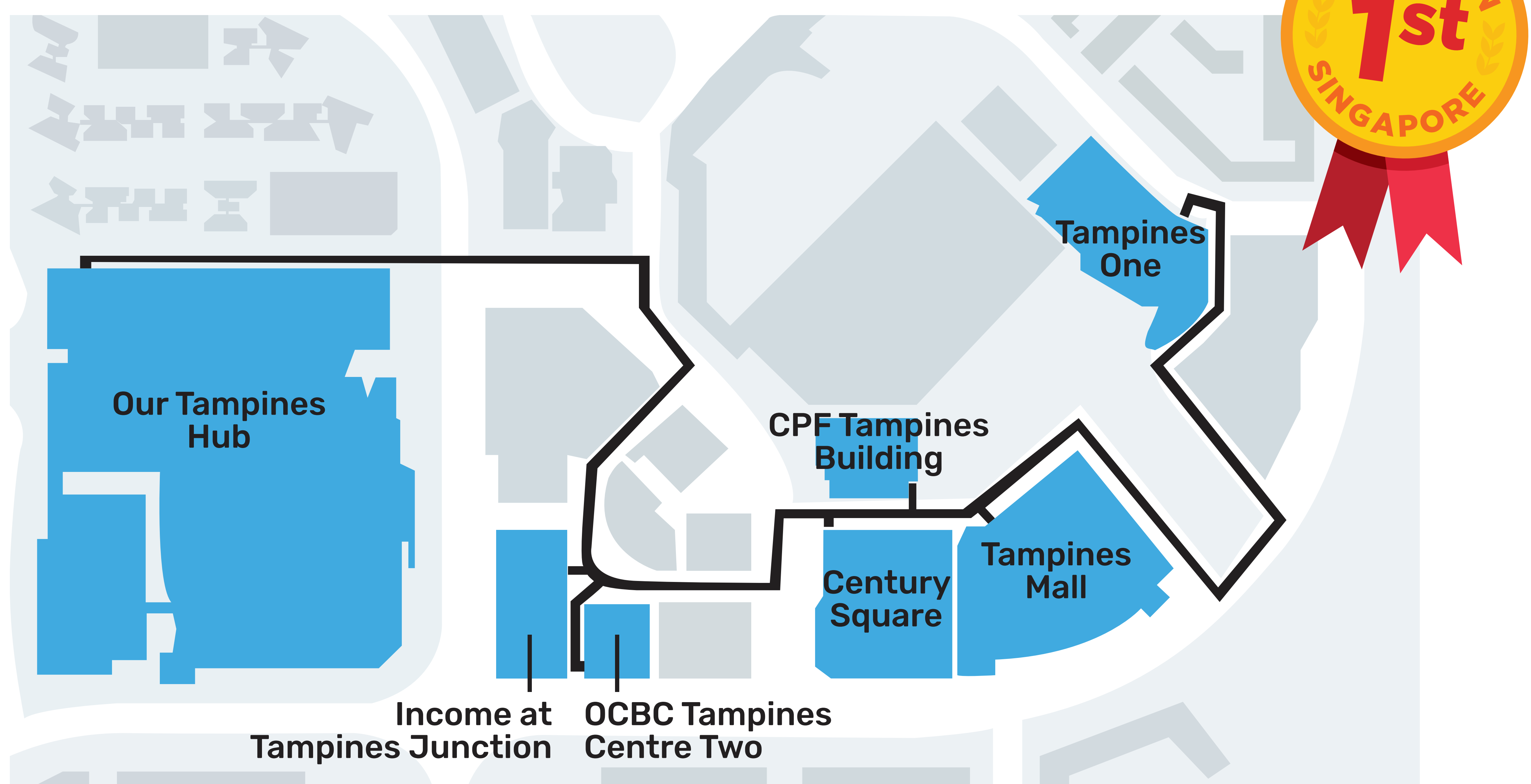

Smart Cooling In The Town Centre

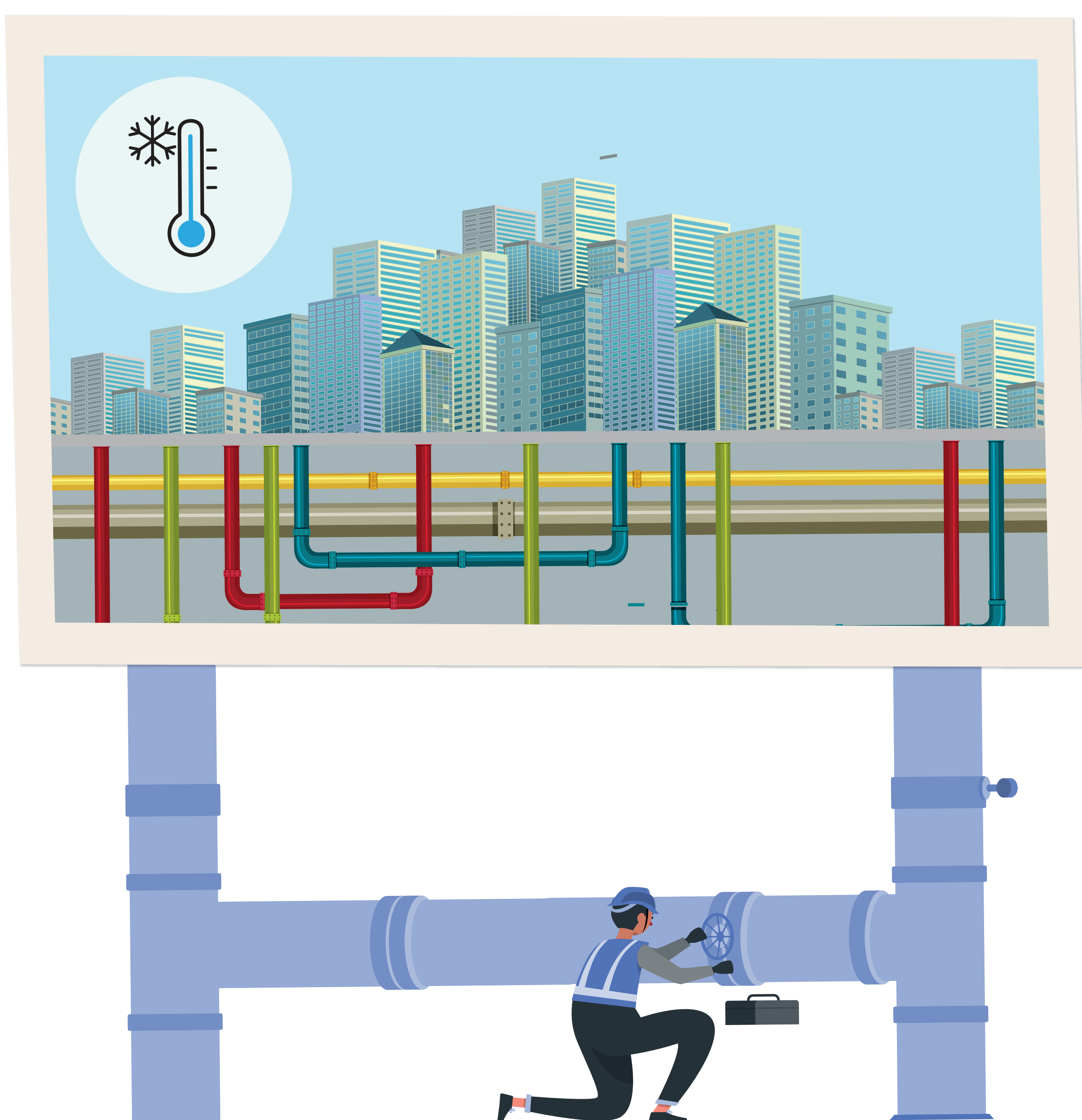
Singapore's First Brownfield Distributed District Cooling Network

provides cooling comfort while achieving:

- **11%** reduction in energy consumption - enough to power **710** three-room HDB households for a year
- **12%** reduction in carbon emissions from both energy savings and refrigerant reduction - equivalent to removing **910** cars from roads



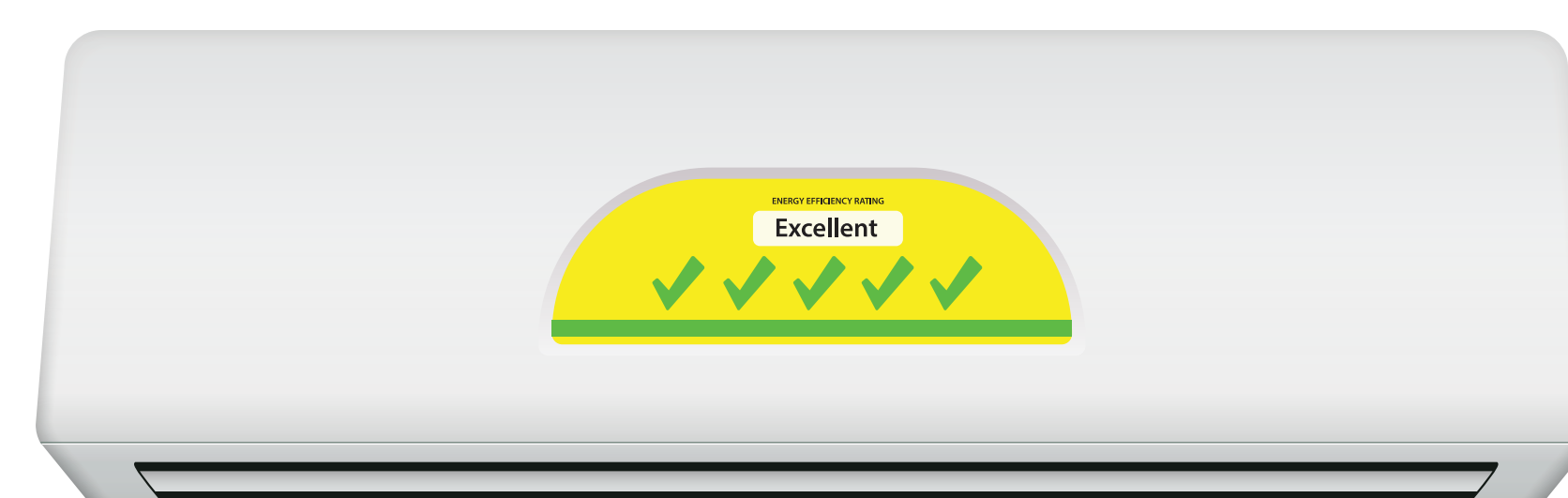
In 2025, the above seven buildings in the regional centre will be retrofitted to plug into the Distributed District Cooling (DDC) Network.



How Does A Distributed District Cooling System Work?

Existing in-building chiller plants are selected based on their existing excess spare capacity and superior energy efficiency.

Buildings are connected through an underground piping network to distribute and circulate chilled water for air-conditioning.



Imagine a giant air conditioner that can cool an entire district, but greener and more energy efficient.

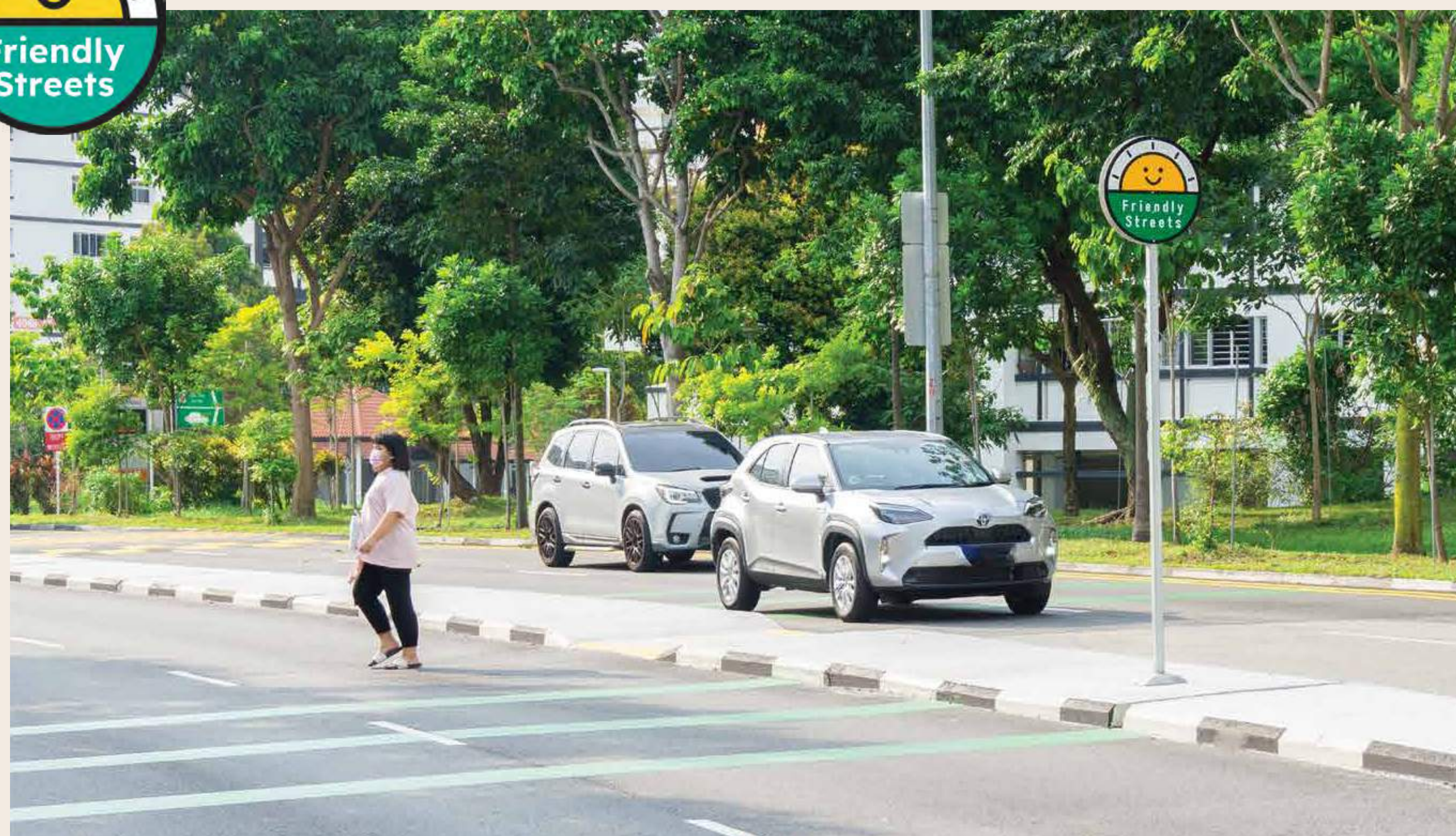

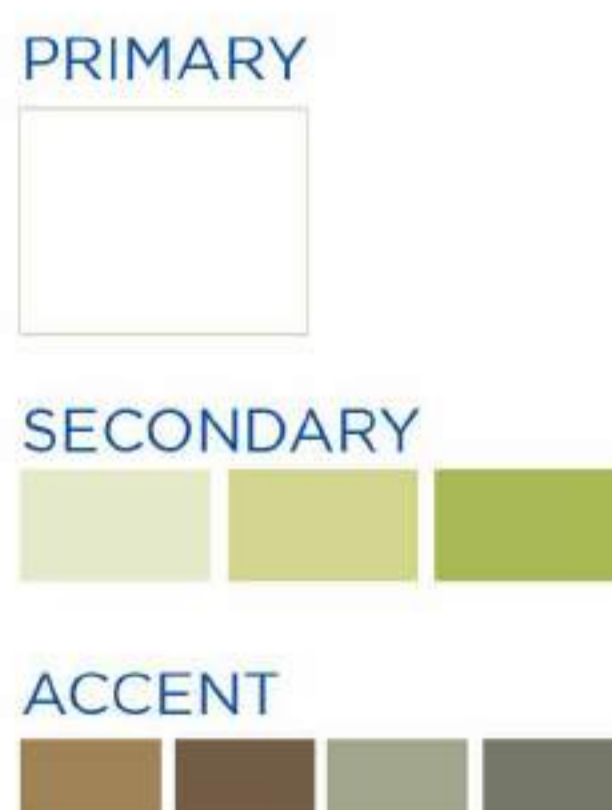
Building the Identity of Our Tampines Neighbourhoods

Colour Scheme Tampines North is a 'green shoot' extension from Tampines Town, designed to blend nature with community living while staying connected to the Regional Centre.

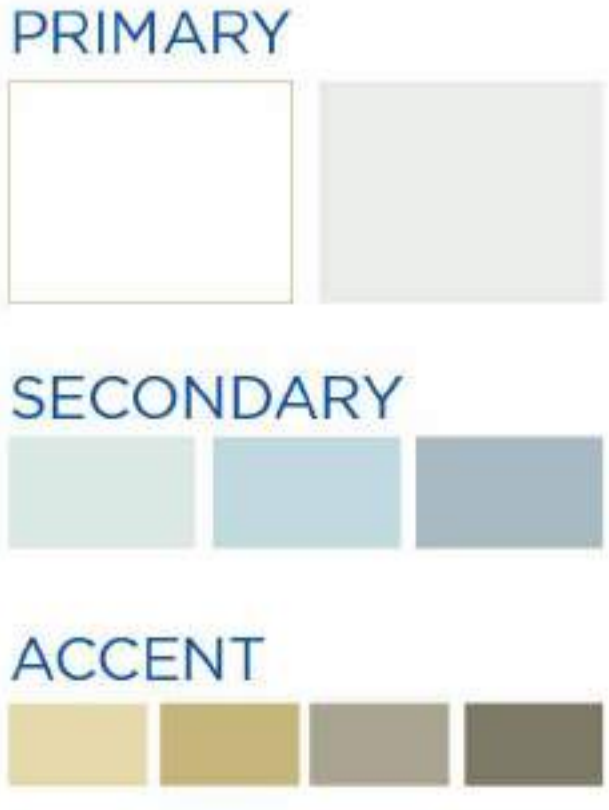

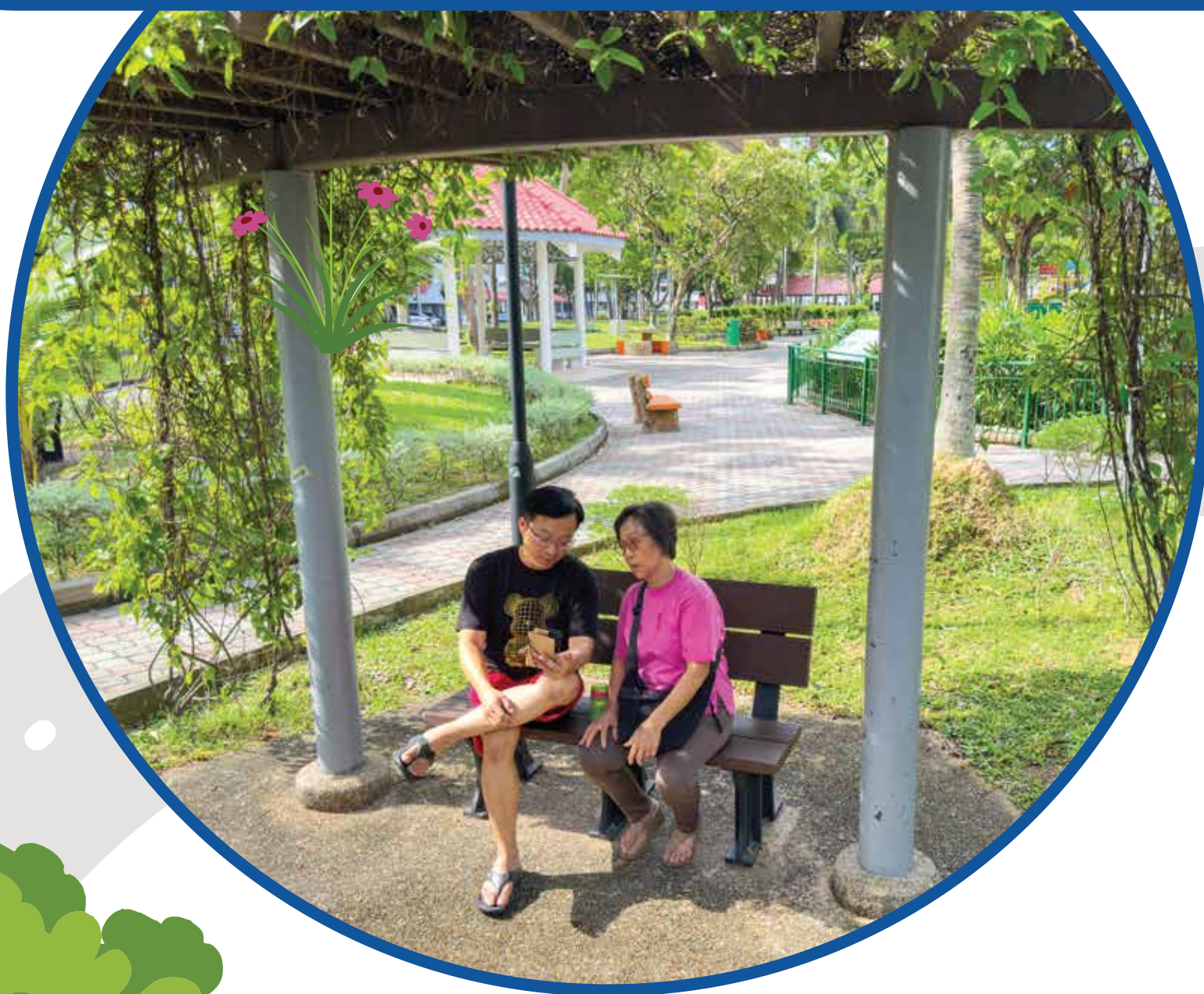
